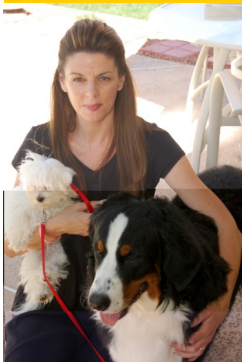

### Allergies

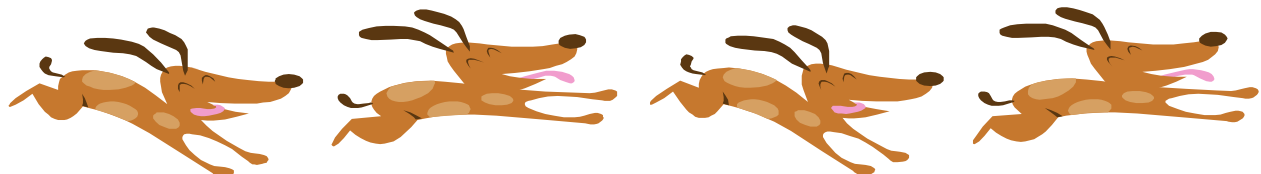
